Purpose of the course unit (module): programme competences to be developed

The purpose of the course is to enable students to acquire theoretical and practical knowledge concerning general provisions, order and conditions of executive proceedings, to build and improve practical skills in a field of executive proceedings, in particular use of the Unified Register of Private Executors of Ukraine and the Unified Register of Debtors, and protection of rights of subjects during executive proceedings.

The course unit topics 1-4 Students will be able to understand and analyse general provisions concerning executive proceedings, in particular: - to analyse Ukrainian legislation on executive proceedings in historical aspect, to provide arguments in favour of students' views of the legal nature of executive proceedings, to analyse legal sources and principles of executive proceedings, to understand the concept of executive relations, to analyse the legal status of its subjects; - to analyse tasks of the State executive service, to understand the legal status of its officials, guarantees of their independence, to analyse requirements to state executors, an order of their appointment and dismissing, to analyse requirements to private executors, to have practical skills concerning using the Unified Register of Private Executors of Ukraine, to understand particularities of private executors' activity; - to analyse requirements to an executive document and particularities of each kind of executive documents; - to analyse the concept and functions of the Automated System of the Executive Proceedings, particularities of access to it, to have practical skills concerning using the Unified Register of Debtors. - to understand the order of complaining decisions, actions or inaction of executors, the consequences of failure to exercise legal requirements of an executor, to have practical skills of writing a complaint about decisions, actions or inaction of an executor.

Examination in written	100	During the examination session	Two open questions to be solved by the students in written, where students are expected to demonstrate the advanced theoretical knowledge of the issues studied during the course and the conceptual understanding of the complexities of executive proceedings. Final exam is evaluated by the 10 points assessment criteria for the final evaluation: - 10 points (excellent), excellent knowledge and abilities; - 9 points (very good), strong, good knowledge and abilities; - 8 points (good), better than average knowledge and abilities; - 7 points (average), average knowledge and abilities, with minor

mistakes; - 6 points (satisfactory), knowledge and abilities are lower than medium, includes some mistakes; - 5 points (weak), knowledge and abilities satisfies minimal requirements;
- 4-1 points – unsatisfactory.
