Examination in written	100	During the examination session	Two practical situations to be solved by students in written, where students are expected to demonstrate advanced theoretical knowledge on the issues studied during the course, conceptual understanding of the complexity of the legal framework of Ukrainian medical law and jurisprudence and ECtHR practice. Final exam is evaluated by the 10 points assessment criteria for the final evaluation: 10 points (excellent), excellent knowledge and abilities; 9 points (very good), strong, good knowledge and abilities; 8 points (good), better than average knowledge and abilities; 7 points (average), average knowledge and abilities, with minor mistakes; 6 points (satisfactory), knowledge and abilities are lower than medium, includes some mistakes; 5 points (weak), knowledge and abilities satisfies minimal requirements; 4-1 points – unsatisfactory.
